## Eligibility Criteria

### Military History

Veterans must have served 90 days of active duty with 1 day during a period of war.

### Medical

The Veteran or spouse must demonstrate the need for assistance from another individual on a regular basis (ADLs) or have a cognitive impairment.

### Income

If care expenses exceed income, the maximum benefit will be awarded.

### Net Worth

The VA considers assets in making its determination; with proper planning, most can become eligible.
